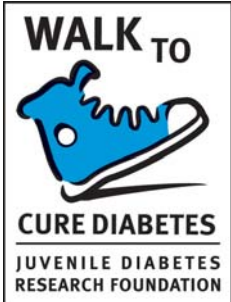




HOSA and JDRF
