## HOW DO YOU APPLY?

National HOSA has one scholarship application and process for all HOSA Scholarship dollars. The HOSA Scholarship application is available at <http://www.hosa.org/member/scholar.html>

## PROCEDURE

Scholarships are available to either a senior secondary or postsecondary student who plans to continue or further his/her education in the health field. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

All applications must be typed, grammatically correct and complete for acceptance and review by HOSA.

All applications are to be submitted by the Local Advisor to the State Advisor. Call your State Advisor for the deadline. State Advisors will select no more than two (2) applications they feel merit further consideration. The HOSA State Advisor will have the applications rated based on the rating sheet. The top two (2) applications will be mailed to the National HOSA Headquarters.

Applications must be postmarked by the State Advisor no later than May 15 for consideration.

Once applicants are selected by the state, a letter will be sent by the State Advisor to the applicant requesting references to be submitted to HOSA Headquarters.

The Award's Committee will make the final decision for the scholarship recipient.
