



OUTSTANDING ALUMNI

Each state will be permitted to nominate one alumni member for the Outstanding Alumni Award. All nominations must be submitted to your HOSA State Advisor to be submitted to National HOSA headquarters by May 15. The "Activity Report" must be completed and submitted for eligibility. A letter(s) of recommendation and a resume from each candidate should accompany the "Activity Report." Each candidate's information will be evaluated by a team of three (3) members to select the outstanding alumni. The national award may be won only one time.

Recognition for this event may include listing on HOSA's website, a recognition pin, and other recognition. Gold, silver and bronze medals are not awarded for this and other recognition events at the national level.

Grading will be based on the following point system:

• Activities and HOSA involvement on a state level as an alumni member	20	
• Activities and HOSA involvement on a national level as an alumni member	15	
• Letter(s) of recommendation	15

The Outstanding Alumni Award will be presented at the HOSA National Leadership Conference. The alumni member does not have to be present for eligibility.
