

HOSA Mini Lesson: Leadership Defined

Objectives:

Upon completion of this lesson, students will have sufficient knowledge of, and be able to:

- 1. define leadership.
- 2. compile a list of the most important characteristics of a leader.
- 3. rate self on identified important characteristics of a leader.
- 4. Identify characteristics they are drawn to and evaluate if those characteristics identify good leaders.

Time:

Lesson – one class period

Materials:

- Internet access
- Paper & pen

Instruction:

- 1. Powerpoint presentation (video 5:00 minutes)
- 2. Students to list ten most important leadership characteristics.
- 3. Students to rate self on leadership characteristics they have identified.
- 4. Vote on the best leader from the Hundred Acre Woods presentation.
- 5. Class discussion of the Hundred Acre Woods members characteristics.

Assessment:

- 1. Class discussion participation.
- 2. List of characteristics & self ratings.
